## **Development of the JANE website**

Following the signature of the consortium agreement, the NHRF team, being responsible for Work Package 2 (Dissemination) and hence for the website construction, started thinking about the design of JANE website addressing technical issues in first place. In collaboration with the NHRF IT officers, we investigated the subcontractors' landscape and determined the technical requirements for hosting the website at NHRF's environment (platforms).

Due to administrative/legislative issues connected with public procurement, which delayed the initiation of the subcontracting process, the real effort started in mid-November right after the JANE Kick-off meeting in Milan. At the kick-off meeting, our first attempts at designing the logo were presented to the General Assembly in order to receive feedback with a view to finalizing this subtask. The main concept regarding the design and function of the website was also presented and the partners agreed that the website should:

- serve the main goals of JANE, therefore, be well-structured and friendly to all users since
  it should secure not only the communication among partners but also address diverse
  target groups;
- present the project's developments in real-time;
- not include an account for social media, rather each of the partners should use their own national social media accounts for providing information on the JANE Joint Action.

Therefore, following further exchange of views with the Coordinating team, the design of the website was developed under the guidance of the WP2 team. From the technical point of view, the website is ready to be transferred and adapted to the NHRF appropriate platform in order to become fully functional. It will be characterized by a modern design, based on the content and goals of the project, adapted to mobile phone & tablet use, friendly to social media and google search as well as compatible with the WCAG 2.0 protocol. It will also be SEO friendly in order to be better promoted through the Google search engine.
